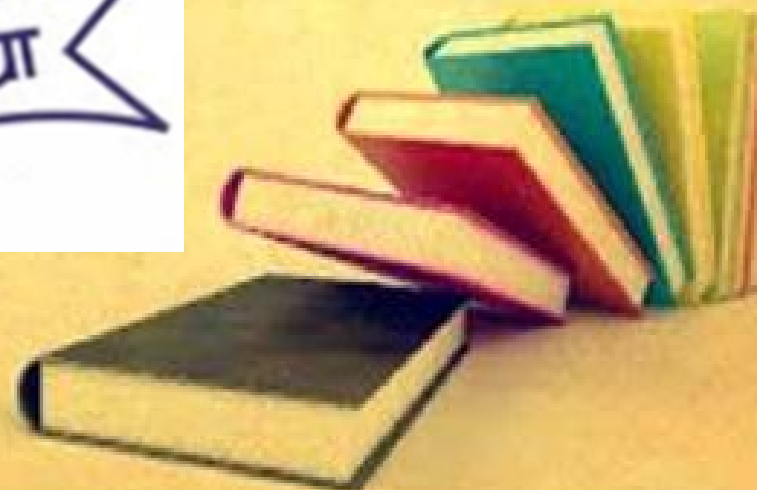

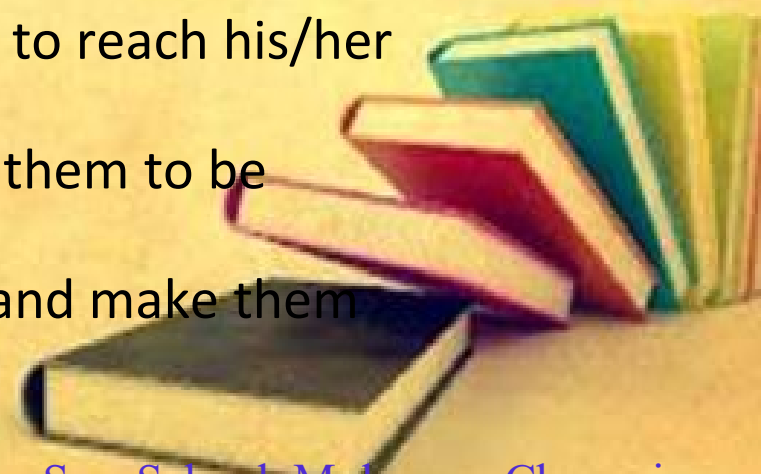
VISION

Legal Studies has been introduced as an elective to commerce students of Class 11 from the academic year 2023-2024.

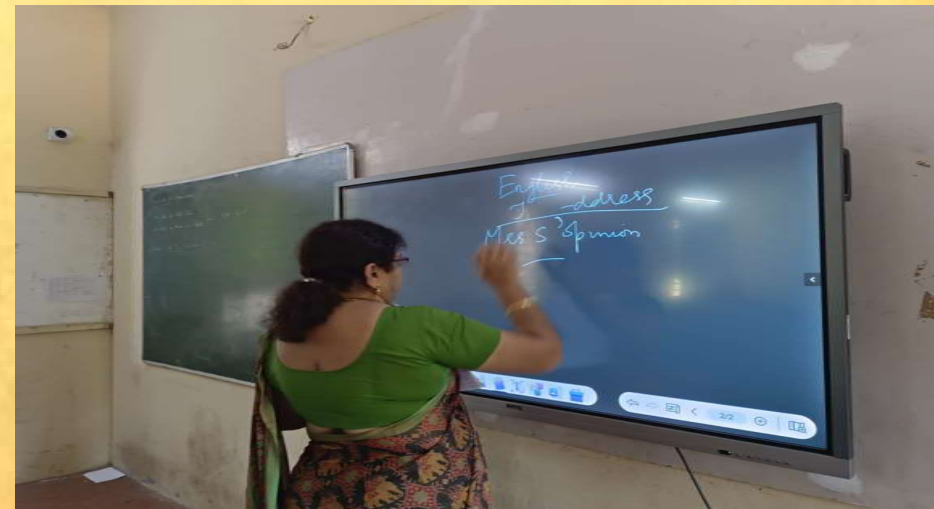
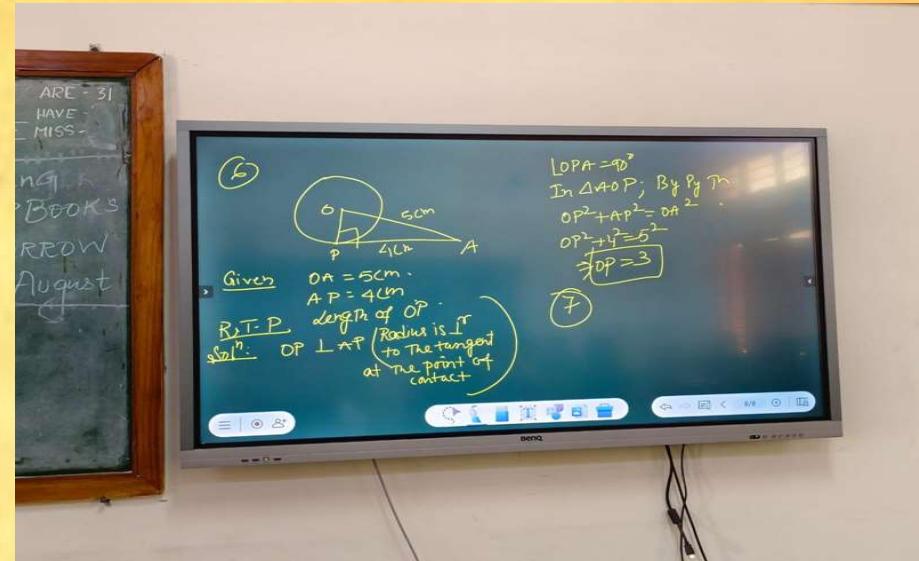




Infrastructure Development

- T- Tactile- Touch or try something in order to learn the concept better.



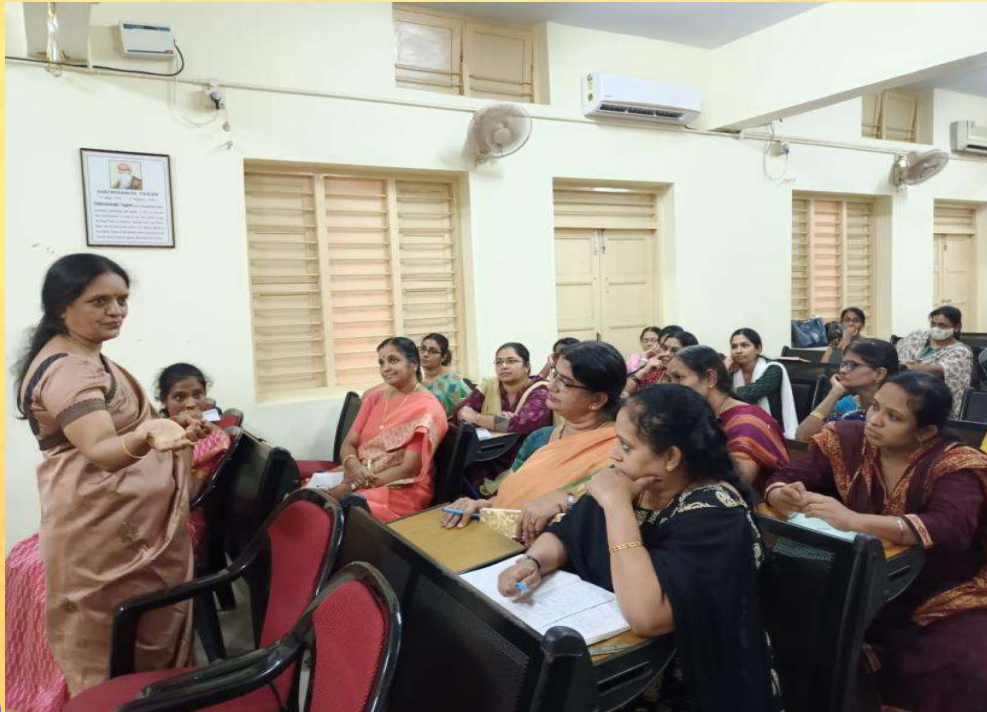
