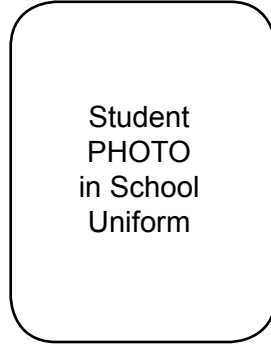

SCHOOL PROGRAMMES ACADEMIC AND ENRICHMENT PROGRAMMES

BLPS

BLPS offers voluntary enrichment sessions for students through story-telling, games and relevant activities. The aim is to motivate students to read books, improve their comprehension and communication skills as well as to foster creative thinking. An add - on library facility is offered to students.

Beyond Boundaries

This is an initiative started with the objective of providing students opportunities to explore beyond their curriculum. A series of lectures are organized in various subject areas by experts drawn from premier institutes in the city.

BMW (Body, Mind and World)

The programme provides an enabling environment for teaching and learning of academic, social and interpersonal skills. Screening of relevant videos / documentaries is organized periodically.

Theatre Workshop

Theatre workshops are organized for students interested in developing soft skills like expression, communication and self confidence.

Scholympics

Regular Quiz programmes form a part of the curriculum. For motivated students Scholympics offers capacity building in Quiz programmes.

Choral Music Classes

Training in choral music through a structured curriculum is offered to students of classes I to V during school hours with the expertise and support of Rhapsody Music Foundation managed by Mr. Anil Srinivasan, well-known composer and Dr. Sudha Raja, choral music expert.

ON GOING SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

Vidya Pravesh

Vidya Pravesh is a unique programme for Class 6 students initiating them into the next phase of learning on completion of their primary education. The students of class 6 take a pledge to lead a life of ethical values, character and take responsibility for their lives and to follow a righteous path in the pursuit of knowledge excellence.

Awakened Citizen Programme

Awakened Citizen Programme is a graded program designed by Ramakrishna Mission to enable and inspire students towards becoming enlightened citizens.

STEM lab

The P.S.Senior STEM lab provides ample opportunities for students to explore the world beyond the curriculum. This lab would help inculcate scientific temper, innovation and thinking in young minds and equip them to solve real-world problems that they encounter in everyday life.

Kala Shiksha classes

Counselling

There is a counsellor in the campus during the school hours. Students may avail the services on request or teachers may suggest to the parents if the teachers feel that such sessions may prove beneficial to the children.

Remedial Classes

Remedial classes are organized for students of all classes who need extra coaching.

Resource Centre

The school has a resource centre with dedicated special educators to help children with learning difficulties by using appropriate strategies

Sports Coaching

Coaching classes are held for major games through the year in Basket Ball, Foot Ball, Table Tennis, Cricket, Athletics and Chess. They are conducted by specialized coaches and the school's sports faculty.

Yoga Classes

Yoga is part of the curriculum for students of Classes VI – XII. Yoga classes are aimed at keeping students fit and flexible physically and mentally. This programme will be extended to students of primary section as well.

Scouts and Guides

Scouts & Guides and Cubs & Bulbuls wing of the school is active. Students are sent for Rajya Puraskar Award, Golden Arrow Award and Standard Judging Competition (State level). They also take part in the Republic Day parade every year.

Veda Classes

Vedic chanting classes are organized on an optional basis every week after school hours for students of classes 6 to 8.

- ❖ Students of classes XI and XII shall have an Epaulet attached to the shirts / kameez. This will be supplied by the school at current cost.
- ❖ Boys of Classes I – XII and Girls of Classes I – VII shall wear the school belt with a buckle carrying the school crest. This will be supplied by the school at current cost.
- ❖ Pupils of all classes from Pre-K.G. should wear identity cards which will be provided by the school
- ❖ Pupils should come to school in full uniform, neatly starched and ironed. Each pupil should try to have a minimum of three sets of uniform so as to ensure cleanliness of uniform.
- ❖ **Hair Style : Girls :** Hairstyle should be neat and not fanciful. Long hair touching the shoulder should be folded, tied with ribbon (plain black) and put up.
Boys : Short hair - not touching the collar / covering the ear.
- ❖ **Shirts :** To be tucked in and buttoned.
- ❖ **Fingers :** Finger nails should be trimmed regularly. No nail polish or nail varnish to be used.
- ❖ **Feet :** Only school black shoes and socks are allowed. Ankle socks are not allowed.
- ❖ **Ornaments :** Gold ornaments, Long ear hangings, fancy earrings are not allowed.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

LEAVE RULES:

- ❖ No pupil shall be absent without taking prior permission.
- ❖ Absence Record should be duly filled by the parent or guardian and submitted to the class teacher for a period of 2 days and to the Principal for longer period.
- ❖ Pupils applying for sick leave may be required to produce medical certificate.
- ❖ Half-a-day leave may be availed only in the case of medical emergencies.
- ❖ In case of sudden illness or other unavoidable circumstances, pupil requiring leave for any part of the day should obtain the permission of the Principal in person along with a parent.

ATTENDANCE:

- ❖ Every pupil should have a minimum of 75% attendance in an academic year. For classes IX – XII kindly ref. CBSE circular regarding attendance in the CBSE website.
- ❖ Attendance on reopening days after term holidays is compulsory
- ❖ Absenteeism without prior permission on reopening days, and after special holidays like Pongal, Deepavali, and also on the eve of terminal examinations will be viewed seriously.
- ❖ Extra classes and revision exams will be arranged for students of Class X - XII during I and II term vacation. Therefore students are advised not to make any plans for holidays. In such cases the parent has to bring the student in person and explain the reason for their absence to the Principal.
- ❖ All students should attend important programmes/functions of the school like the Annual Day, Project Day, Sports Day and any other function as advised. Attendance will be marked on these days.

TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

The following traffic regulations are in force in and near the school and students should help in enforcing them. Parents and others are requested to co-operate by strictly observing them

- ❖ Cycling within the school campus is not allowed.
- ❖ Auto Rickshaws/Cars/Vans should not be parked on the approach road to the school.

- ❖ Vehicles should not be parked in the area of the road opposite the school gate since this will obstruct and cause inconvenience to other vehicles and children coming to the school.
- ❖ Drivers and other escorts who come to take the children should wait only in the place allotted for them. They should not enter the classes or move about in any other part of the campus.
- ❖ One-way traffic regulations brought into vogue for the convenience of pupils should be honoured by one and all.

PARENTAL CO-OPERATION:

- ❖ Parents are specially requested to see the Calendar daily for any remark or communication from the class teacher and to act on them.
- ❖ No pupil suffering from a contagious disease should be sent to the school until recovery, which should be supported by Medical Certificate.
- ❖ Parents are requested not to permit the children to carry any money with them other than for specific purposes.
- ❖ Parents are advised not to send individual gifts/cakes for all the students on their child's birthday. You may, if you wish to, send branded chocolates only.
- ❖ A record of the address and telephone number of the parents / guardians are maintained at the school office. Any change of address or telephone number should be communicated without fail.

GENERAL RULES FOR PUPILS

- ❖ Students must be in the school premises at least 10 minutes before the first bell. Late coming and not coming in proper uniform are not permitted.
- ❖ Every student must carry his School Diary to school every day.
- ❖ Students are responsible for their books and belongings.
- ❖ Students are not allowed to wear smart watches and valuables in the interest of their safety. They are not allowed to carry mobile phones, multimedia games etc to school
- ❖ English is the spoken language in the school as it is the medium of instruction.

- ❖ Campus Discipline: Movement of pupils should be orderly during morning assemblies and when proceeding to PT classes, lab periods, Computer Science classes and library classes.
- ❖ Children should refrain from running in the campus during school hours (except on the playground).
- ❖ Bullying or ragging has become rampant in schools causing serious concern to students, teachers, parents and school authorities. Bullying / ragging is strictly prohibited and such disgraceful acts will be punished.
- ❖ Stringent irrevocable action will be taken against students who indulge in such shameful acts of bullying directly through physical intimidation, verbal abuse or indirectly through emails, SMS or spreading malicious rumours.
