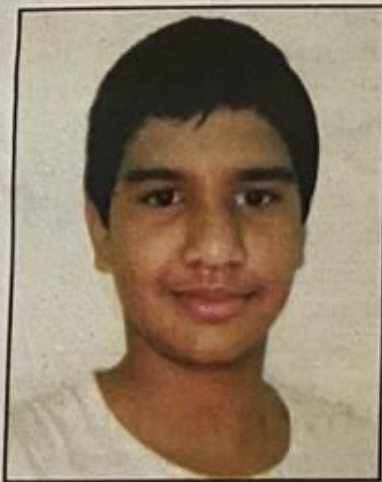
## Cricket team of P. S. Senior excels in TNCA tourney



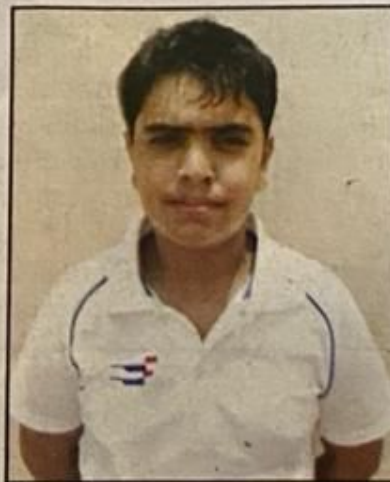
